

3.0 Title VI Notice to the Public

3.1 Notice to Public

Recipients must notify the public of its rights under Title VI and include the notice and where it is posted in the Title VI Plan. The notice must include:

- A statement that the agency operates programs without regard to race, color and national origin
- A description of the procedures members of the public should follow in order to request additional information on the grantee's nondiscrimination obligations
- A description of the procedure members of the public should follow in order to file a discrimination complaint against the grantee

3.2 Notice Posting Locations

The Notice to Public will be posted at many locations to apprise the public of Dodge County Transit System's obligations under Title VI and to inform them of the protections afforded them under Title VI. At a minimum, the notice will be posted in public areas of Dodge County Transit System's office(s) including the reception desk and meeting rooms, and on the Dodge County Transit System's website at dodgecountyga.com. Additionally, Dodge County Transit System will post the notice at stations, stops and on transit vehicles.
