- Update Section IV - Require a \$1 million liability insurance policy, no surety bond.
- Update Section V - License fee to \$150
- Revise Section VII, item four (4) to be covered by the county alcohol ordinance.
- Strike VII, item 8 in its entirety which details “pool”.

2. Fortune Telling

- Strike the Ordinance

3. Sewage Management

- Compare to state ordinance for any policy revisions
- Section 10 – add specific details for penalty \$1,000 fine or 60 days in jail
- Allow public health to review

4. Speed Limits

- Research to determine if GDOT requires this document.

5. County Road 139

- Strike the Ordinance

6. Litter Control

- General inquiries regarding location of current dumpsites
- Identify Magistrate Court for cases to be heard

7. Recreation and Amendments

- Attorney Harrington referenced an amendment for no parties with alcohol and should end by midnight. Also, he referenced a no fighting clause. The amendment wasn't in the Ordinance Book. To circle back to this item after searching for the amendment.

8. Picketing
