

**Road Committee Minutes**  
**Dodge County Board of Commissioners**

The Dodge County Road Committee held a meeting at the Dodge County Pearl Bates Courthouse Annex Wednesday, October 11, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. with County Manager Bearden presiding. He called the meeting to order, and the Commissioner Cheek led a prayer.

**Business:**

- The committee reviewed the LMIG list and revised to include the following. (The LMIG grant will be \$955,104.12 with a required match of 10% - \$95,510.41.)

Lennie Lane	paving double surface treatment
Lantie Drive	paving double surface treatment
Grace Drive	paving double surface treatment
Garrett Oxley	aggregate coarse surface
Paul Milner Road	aggregate coarse surface
Ragan Avenue	paving asphalt
Spivey Road	aggregate coarse surface
Sycamore Drive	aggregate coarse surface
AG Best	paving double surface treatment
Bedsole Road	paving asphalt

- Next, the committee discussed motor grader districts and reviewed number of roads per operator, which varied from 45 to 67 roads between five operators. (Manager Bearden is compiling mileage per operator, as well.) The committee recommended hiring two more motor grader operators.
- Attorney Daniels presented proposed revision to the county road ordinance, Section 18-55 concerning private driveways, as follows:
  - (a) No landowner shall connect a private driveway, drive, road or other private way which connects two or more residences or multiple parcels of land (hereinafter in this section collectively "private driveway") to a county roadway without first obtaining the written permission of the board or commissioners or their designee.
- Attorney Daniels notified the county manager he had the paperwork ready to sign for Hobbs Road, which will allow the county to begin the process of abandoning the road.
- Manager Bearden updated regarding signage for speed bumps on Church Street and stated he anticipated speed bumps to be in place the first or second week of December.

- The board reviewed the minutes from the meeting on September 13, 2023, and voiced no objections.
