The Dodge County Board of Commissioners held a called meeting for SPLOST negotiations at the Dodge County Pearl Bates Courthouse Annex Thursday, July 11, 2024, at 5:00 p.m. with Chairman McCranie presiding. He called the meeting to order, and Commissioner Cheek gave the invocation. Next, he led the Pledge of Allegiance. Chairman McCranie open the floor to the cities for their SPLOST requests.

City of Chauncey

Mayor Harrell Burch requested an increase in SPLOST funds from 1.5% to 3% for road, sewer, and water improvements.

Town of Chester

Mayor Glynn Pittman requested an increase from 1.5% to 3% and stated it was needed for a lot of projects in Chester.

City of Eastman

City Council Chairman Graham Snyder requested the city's SPLOST percentage remain at 21% and the hospital remain at 15%. He presented a handout with potential SPLOST expenditures from the city.

City of Milan

Mayor Chad Puckett requested an increase from 1.5% to 3% for major repairs on the water and sewage system. Also, a few road issues need to be addressed.

City of Rhine

Mayor Hardy Eady requested an increase from 1.5% to 3% for street and water improvements and to help with managing limb debris removal.

Dodge County

Chairman McCranie thanked the cities for their attendance and input.
