

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE THE DODGE COUNTY, GA GUIDELINES FOR BUILDING/ CONSTRUCTION PERMITTING AROUND THE HEART OF GEORGIA REGIONAL AIRPORT.

WHEREAS it is in the best interest of Dodge County to establish building/ construction permitting standards that will reduce risk associated approaches and landings in and around the Heart of Georgia Regional Airport,

WHEREAS these risks can be mitigated through proper filings with the County and the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA),

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Dodge County as follows:

- A. Any person constructing or altering an existing structure, within the jurisdiction of Dodge County and within a three (3) mile radius of the Heart of Georgia Regional Airport must complete and submit to the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) form 7460-1 prior to submitting a request for permit with the Dodge County Building Inspector. A copy of the submission and FAA response will be required when applying for a permit.
- B. Any person constructing or altering an existing structure, within the jurisdiction of Dodge County and between a three (3) and five (5) mile radius of the Heart of Georgia Regional Airport must complete and submit to the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) form 7460-1, if the structure will exceed a height of two hundred (200) feet, prior to submitting a request for permit with the Dodge County Building Inspector. If required to file, a copy of the submission and FAA response will be required when applying for a permit.
- C. Any person constructing or altering an existing structure, within the jurisdiction of Dodge County and further than five (5) mile radius of the Heart of Georgia Regional Airport will not be required submit the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) form 7460-1. A Dodge County building permit will still be required.
