Call to Order

The Dodge County Board of Commissioners held a public hearing at the Dodge County Pearl Bates Courthouse Annex Monday, October 20, 2025, at 5:30 p.m. with Chairman Dan McCranie presiding. Chairman McCranie called the public hearing to order and opened the floor for public comments.

Bradley Mullis, resident of Coleman Cemetery Road, voiced objections against shutting down Coleman Road due to it being an access point to Coleman Cemetery Road.

Ty Peacock reiterated objections to the abandonment of Coleman Road.

Henry Walker, a property owner on Coleman Road, stated he was fine with the road closing or staying open.

Jimbo Dixon, a resident on Coleman Road stated the road was in disrepair, and he was trying to maintain it with his equipment, which led to the discussion of closing the road. Also, the resident's home is only 27 feet from the roadway, which he felt was a safety concern.

Commissioner Flanagan made a motion to adjourn at 5:57 p.m. Commissioner Watkins seconded. All voted in favor, and the motion passed.
